

Privacy Policy

Ipsen Pharma SAS with an address at 65 Quai Georges Gorse, 92650 Boulogne-Billancourt, France and or its affiliates (“Ipsen” or “us” or “we”) is organizing the LATAM-UZA NET Preceptorship (“Event”), and Ipsen, its affiliate or its partner has invited you to attend the Event and or to access the website ipsen-connect.com (“Website”).

This Privacy Policy describes how personal information of individuals (“users” or “you”) attending the Event and or accessing or using the Website will be processed by or on behalf of Ipsen.

Ipsen is the data controller with respect to the processing of your personal information as set out below.

Data collected

The personal information we collect, process and store about you may include the following:

- Full Name
- Email address
- Medical specialty
- Country of practice
- Password
- Information regarding your connection / access to the Event: connection date and time to the Event, total connection time to the Event, access and download of the event materials,
- Any other personal information relating to you that you provide to us as part of your participation to the Event, such as questions and comments posted in the Event chat.

If you wish to attend the Event or access the Website, these categories of personal information are mandatory.

Purpose and legal basis of data processing

We will use personal information relating to you for the purposes of:

- Inviting you at the Event or to access the Website
- Registering you at the Event or the Website, organizing the Event and ensuring your attendance at the Event
- Following up with you after the Event with respect to the Event (including without limitation for satisfaction survey, CME credits)
- Responding to your questions or other communication (e.g. Pharmacovigilance, Medical Information) during the Event.
- Following up with you after the Event with respect to the Event, and or any questions or other communication (e.g. PV, Medical Information) that you raised during the Event.
- Complying with legal or regulatory obligations that apply to Ipsen (e.g. pharmacovigilance, transparency obligations) or to respond to legal requests from administrative or judicial authorities, in accordance with applicable laws.

Depending on the data processing at stake, Ipsen will process your personal information on either one of the following legal basis:

- the “legitimate interests” pursued by Ipsen: ensuring your registration and attendance at the Event, ensuring follow-up with you after the Event, ensuring your access to the Website;
- to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations.

Data recipients

Information related to you will only be accessed by Ipsen’s and its affiliates’ personnel with a relevant and tangible need to see your information for the purpose mentioned above.

We may disclose your personal information to third parties in connection with the above purposes, including:

- third parties who we engage to provide services to us in connection with the Event and or the Website, such as outsourced service providers, IT services providers, professional advisers and auditors;
- other members of our group or affiliates;
- competent regulatory authorities and bodies as requested or required by law.

Your personal information will not be shared or otherwise distributed to third parties without your consent, except where we are required to do so because of an applicable law, court order or governmental regulation, or if such disclosure is otherwise necessary in support of any criminal or other legal investigation or proceeding here or abroad.

Your personal information will not be sold.

Term of retention

Your information will be retained for five (5) years.

International transfers of data

Your personal data may be processed by service providers or companies affiliated with Ipsen in non-EU countries which do not ensure an adequate level of protection to personal data. In order to ensure that your personal data are protected, Ipsen will, where necessary, enter into data transfer agreements which include the EU Commission’s standard contractual clauses, or will adopt Binding Corporate Rules (BCRs) for transfers of personal data within the group of companies. Such contract or BCRs can be made available to you upon request.

Your Rights

You may have the following rights regarding your information depending on the circumstances and applicable legislation:

Right	What does this mean?
The right of access	You have the right to obtain access to the information processed by Ipsen.
The right to rectification	You are entitled to have your information corrected if it is inaccurate or incomplete.
The right to erasure	This is also known as ‘the right to be forgotten’ and, in simple terms, enables you to request the deletion or removal of your information where there is no compelling reason for Ipsen to

	keep using it. This is not a general right to erasure; there are exceptions.
The right to restrict processing	You have rights to 'block' or suppress further use of your information in certain circumstances. When processing is restricted, Ipsen can still store your information, but may not use it further.
The right to data portability	You have rights to obtain and reuse your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format in certain circumstances.
The right to object	You have the right to object to certain types of processing, in certain circumstances.
